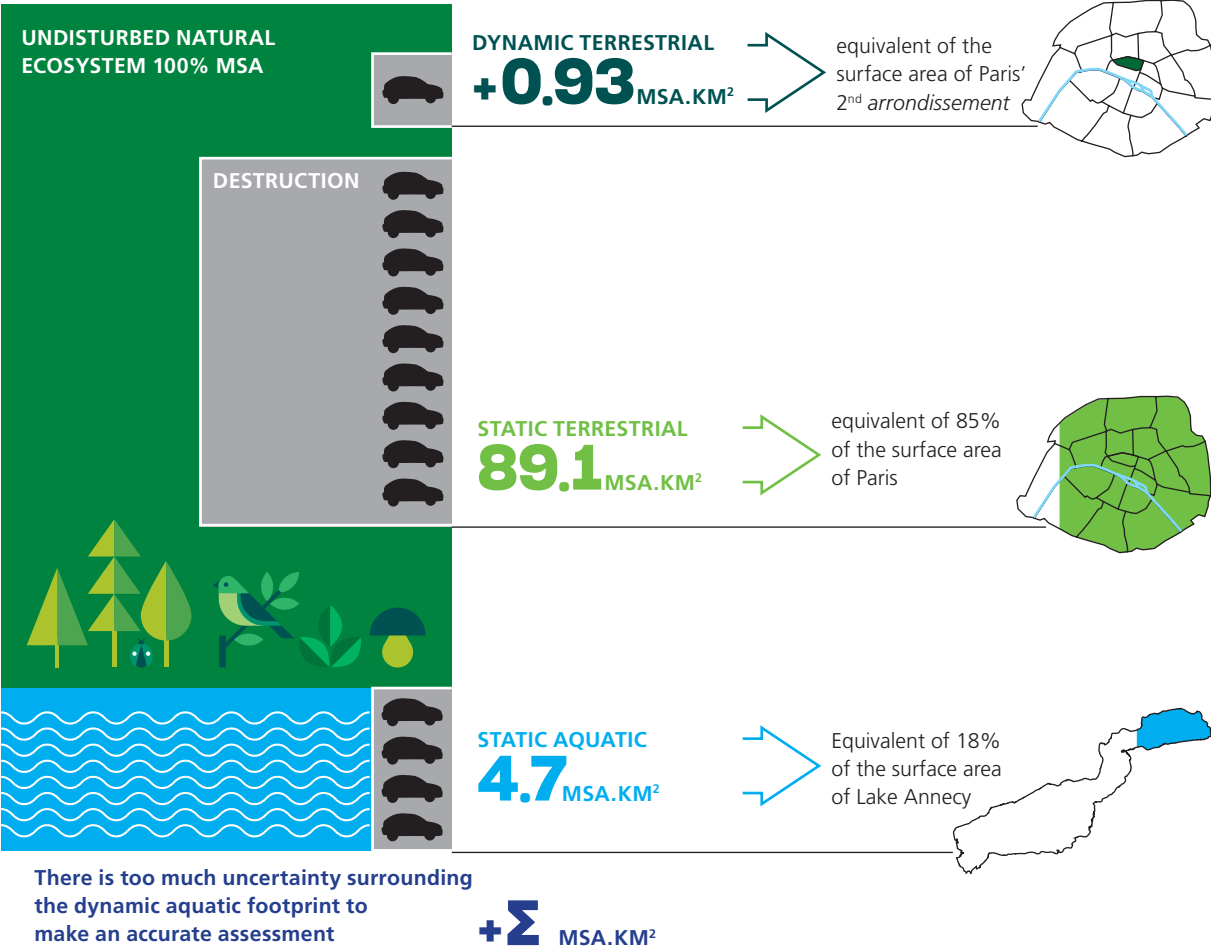

 - for heating and cooling networks, is based on the French decree of 5 July 2024 amending the decree of 15 September 2006 on energy performance diagnostics for existing non-residential buildings or portions of buildings offered for sale in metropolitan France.
